# “IBERWINE 2009 Awards” Competition Conditions

## Article 1.- Eligibility.

The International Wine Competition “Iberwine 2009 Awards” offers all brands of bottled and labelled wines, from both Spanish and foreign wineries which fulfil the Conditions herein, to enter the “Iberwine 2009 Awards” competition.

## Article 2.- Registration of Samples.

Each sample must be accompanied by the corresponding Registration Form, filled in by the winery or company, or authorized person on their behalf, and must include the following information:

- Details of the Winery or Company (name, address, phone, fax, email, etc. ), and details of the contact person.
- Wine Sample Information:
  - Producer name
  - Brand name
  - Vintage
  - Varietal or prevailing varieties which the wine has been made.
  - Category (1 to 16)
  - Appellation of Origin or other geographic designations.
  - Wine Stock
  - Recommended retail price

The completion of the Registration Form and the issue of payment imply the acceptance of these regulations and the result of the Competition.

Of the four samples, three will be made available to the Tasting Panel and one will be registered and stored in Emporio Ferial, S.A. until the 1st of February 2010, at which time the period of appeal concludes.

## Article 3.- Classification.

The samples will be classified according to the following Categories:

**Category 1.** Dry white wines, from the 2008 and 2007 harvests, or previous, un-wooded.

**Category 2.** Dry white wines, fermented or aged in wood.

**Category 3.** Semi-dry or semi-sweet white wines with a residual sugar content of more than 4g/l.

**Category 4.** Rosé wines from the 2008 and 2007 harvests, or previous.

**Category 5.** Red wines from the 2008 and 2007 harvests, including those made with carbonic maceration and those wines with short ageing in wood.

**Category 6.** Red wines from the 2006, 2005 or 2004 harvests, with or without oak ageing.

**Category 7.** Red wines from harvests before 2004, including “crianzas”, “reservas” and “grandes reservas”

**Category 8.** Sparkling wines made using the traditional method.

**Category 9.** Sparkling wines made using other methods.

**Category 10.** Semi-sparkling wines.

**Category 11.** Liqueur wines: Fortified dry.

**Category 12.** Liqueur wines: Fortified liqueur.

**Category 13.** Liqueur wines: Natural sweet wines.

**Category 14.** Other liqueur wines.

**Category 15.** Sweet wines from very aromatic grapes (Moscatel, Malvasia . . .), not included in Categories 12 to 14.

**Category 16.** Wines from extra mature grapes, but included in the chapter number 24 of Annex I of the Regulation (EC) 1493/99, and not included in Categories 12 to 14.

## Article 4.- Direction of the Competition.

The Direction of the Competition is the responsibility of Emporio Ferial, S.A., organizing company and convener of the 10th edition of the “IBERWINE Awards”.

## Article 5. Monitoring of the samples.

The Organization of the Competition, through the designated persons, will monitor the reception and registration system of the samples, stated in Article 2.

The wine Samples presented must meet the conditions established by the Vine and Wine Law 24/2003 and be in accordance with the definitions established by the O.I.V. (International Organisation of Vine and Wine) and by the European Union legislation, which appears in Annex I of the Regulation (CE) 1493/99.

Likewise the labelling, especially with respect to the use of Denominations of Origin or geographical names, will respect the precepts of Regulation (EC) 1493/99 and complementary legislation.

The bottles will be presented with their complete

labelling, being checked at the time of registration the identity of the information that appears on the Registration Form with the label.

Once registration is complete, each sample bottle will be covered in such a way that the label and capsule are hidden, and will be identified with a random number, which will accompany the sample throughout the tasting process, until the Awards are proclaimed.

## Article 6. – Tasting Regulations.

The Organizers guarantee that the tasting is carried out with the absolute anonymity of the samples. Wines will be given a score out of 100 points. The tasting form used will be the one approved by the O.I.V. and the International Oenologists Union.

The tasters will only mark the corresponding box of the form. The tasting chairman will collect the forms for their calculation.

The sum of the valid points of the different wine tasters which form the panel will determine the final score of each sample. In case of divergent scores, the Chairman will order the repetition of the tasting by another tasting group or table of the Panel.

## Article 7.- Tasting Panel

The Tasting Panel, appointed by the Director of the Competition, will be made up of highly qualified tasters, with outstanding experience in Competitions both in Spain and abroad.

The Panel meetings will take place during the last two weeks of November 2009, and will be held at the premises of Emporio Ferial.

## Article 8.- Awards.

Gold and Silver Medal Diplomas will be awarded to those wines with the fifty highest scores.

– **Golden Metal:** the ten highest scores.

– **Silver Metal:** the next forty highest scores.

The total number of awards cannot exceed the 20% of the samples presented.

A second tasting of the wines which have been awarded a Gold Medal will be conducted in order to determine the winner of the **IBERWINE Grand Prize.**
